

Introduction

Welcome to the Half Nite Scatter. This event has 24 controls with a maximum 18 to be visited in 2½ hours. Codes are located at the point where a footpath meets a road, making locating the code relatively easy. Plotting is by KM squares to give a starting junction, then a diagram, giving the departure from that junction to the control. Results will be given as soon after the last car has finished as possible.

1. Announcement

Stockport 061 Motor Club will organise a Navigational Scatter Event on 26/27 June 2010 starting at the Duke of York (119/119 675).

2. Jurisdiction

The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the MSA (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

3. Authorisation

An MSA Clubsport Permit No has been applied for.

4. Eligibility

This event is open to: -

- a) All fully elected members of the organising club.
- b) Members of the following invited clubs:
Matlock MC, Mid Derbyshire MC, Knutsford & DMC, Ecurie Royal Oak MC, Rotherham MC and Warrington & DMC.

5. All competitors must produce a valid Club Membership Card. Please note that a Competition Licence is not required.

6. Programme

Total mileage will be approximately 80 miles.

10. Entries
