

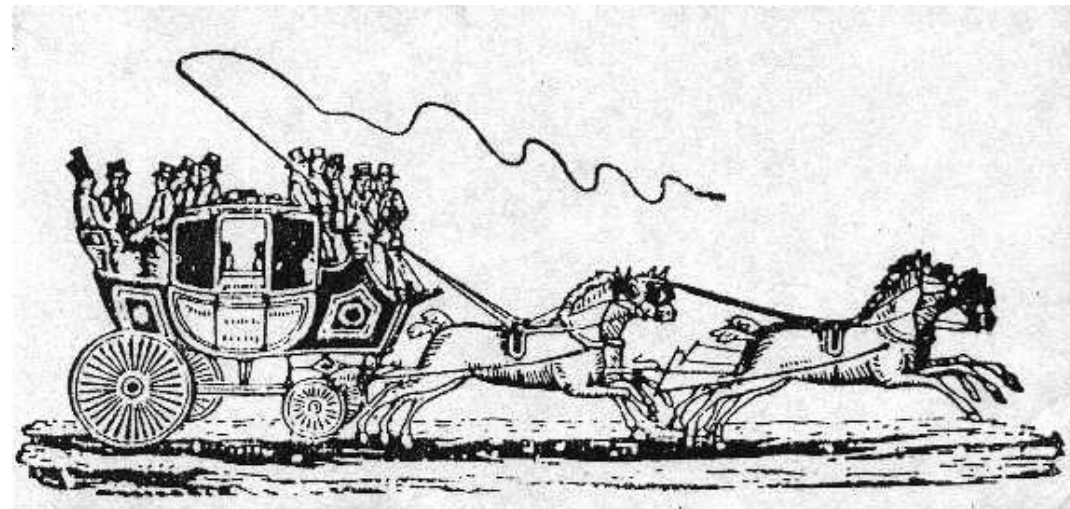
HALF NITE SCATTER 2010 RESULTS

There was a good collection of 2 point scores visited by many crews. Showing the top scores should not be your only aim. First back, if you discount Daryl/Darren, were Martin/Sam, they did not have a reliable clock so made sure they were not late. Fourth place a good result for the young Sam on his first big scatter. Two crews managed to arrive on their minute, Mark/Matthew collecting the Youlgreave code close to the finish. Peter/Nigel the eventual winners running out of time to collect Youlgreave! Rob/Julian came a close second; both navigators finding the roads affected their stomachs. Weags Bridge hairpins, done three times by Julian, after miss plotting the control the start for him. Nigel's decision to go to Sheldon from High Edge the difference between the crews, allowing them to get one more control, those two points made the difference. David/Sally started with a 2 point score to give them confidence, then collected 16 controls helping them to 3rd. Jeremy/Jeremy also started with 2 points just round the corner from the start. Arriving with four minutes to spare, they could have managed Youlgreave, if they had not collected the 2 pointer, but it would have been close. Late entry Barbara/Brian showed they had enough pace, choosing the route I thought was the best from the start. Brian having to get out to collect the codes did cost them time though. Mark/Matthew had a puncture and wet engine driving through Tissington ford. This delay cost the dearly only managing 10 controls. David/Sally managed a route choice using the faster roads in the north half of the event. The big points were however in the south on the narrow twisty lanes. Mathew/Martin tried a spiral route but being new to the event found the codes difficult to find.
